Legislative Report

Stop the 34-Year Wait - Deliver Toxic - Exposed Veterans the Care They've Earned

Veterans exposed to toxic substances life Agent Orange, chenicals released by burn pits, and radiation should not have to fight for decades to prove their illnesses are service connected. Yet, according to a recent report from MOAA and DAV, toxic exposed veterans wait over 34 years on average before receiving presumptive service connection and the care they've earned. The PACT Act was a historic step forward, but its work isn't complete.

Congress must pass legislation to bolster the legal framework for establishing presumptive conditions, creating clear timelines and processes to move from exposure acknowledgement to the delivery of earned benefit. This commonsense reform will cut through red tape, improve VA accountability, and end the long wait faced by millions of veterans.
